Doctors from KIMS Hospitals provided free medical services to nearly **133 beneficiaries**, including **Blood Pressure (BP)** and **Blood Sugar tests**, health consultations, and distribution of prescribed medicines.

In association with **Bharat Vikas Parishad**, **Hemoglobin tests** were conducted, and iron tablets were distributed to individuals diagnosed with anemia. Additionally, under the aegis of **Raktdaan Trust**, **Blood Group Determination Tests** were carried out for students.
